- Our largest program, the School-Based department, will provide experience working with diverse student bodies in a school setting. We have the most availability for field placements in this program.
- Interns may need to be available during the school day if they work with children during the school year.
- Flexibility in earning your required hours and achieving your desired goals.
- Opportunities to attend agency trainings to develop skills and clinical knowledge.
- Eligible placement for the Great Minds Fellowship.

*Beech Brook is a recognized Community Behavioral Health Center with "The Great Minds Fellowship" to support Ohio students pursuing degrees or certificates in social work, therapy, and counseling within two years of graduation. Fellows interning at Beech Brook can earn up to \$10,000 in scholarship funds.

- Undergraduates working towards a degree in social work or psychology.
- Graduate students working towards a degree in social work, counseling, or marriage and family therapy.
- Psychology students must complete 6+ hours per week, enroll in PSY 391 for 2-4 credits
