FMA JOHN A. LONSAK STUDENT PRODUCTION FUND AWARD APPLICATION

The FMA John A. Lonsak Student Production Fund Award is to be used in support of a student film production that is produced during the semester applied. Applicants must be a major in the School of Film & Media Arts with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, be of **Junior or Senior** standing, and currently enrolled in an advanced production course (**300 and 400 level production classes**).

The following material is required along with this completed application:

- One page description of the proposed project. Include the following information: title of project; logline; narrative, documentary or experimental; projected running time; applicant's role(s); other attached student crew members; expected shoot dates
- A screenplay, or a visual treatment/synopsis for the proposed project
- One-page budget: List of estimated expenses such as: props/setting, location fees, catering/craft services, make-up, wardrobe, music rights, etc.
- A brief statement of how awarded funds would impact your project

All recipients of this award must agree to:

- Include the following film credit: "Recipient of the CSU John A. Lonsak Student Production Fund Award."
- Provide FMA a digital file and DVD of finished film by the academic year's end, for presentation to donor.
- Provide FMA with a written report detailing how the funds were used.
