

Department of Mathematics and Statistics Credit by Examination Policy

A student may acquire credit by examination for any undergraduate course offered by the Department of Mathematics and Statistics numbered MTH 148, MTH 149, MTH 167, MTH 168, MTH 181, MTH 182, MTH 220, MTH 281, MTH 283, MTH 284, MTH 286, MTH 288, STA 147, STA 323, while following these guidelines:

1. Credit by examination is available to matriculated, degree-seeking students only.
2. The student must have passed (at CSU) all prerequisite courses or must be placed in the course by the CSU Math Placement Exam.
3. The student cannot have attempted the course at CSU.
4. The student cannot have previously attempted credit by examination for the course.
5. A student cannot use credit by examination for a course if the student already has credit for a more advanced course. (Note: A higher course number does not necessarily denote a more advanced course.)
6. The Department of Mathematics and Statistics will provide the student with a current syllabus for the course on which the examination is based.
7. The student must pay the credit by examination fee at the Cashier's Office before The student takes the examination.
8. On a pre-arranged date (about two weeks after the payment) the student will take the examination either at the CSU Testing Services (Rhodes Tower West, # 215) or in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics. The student will have two hours to complete the exam. The passing grade is 85% or above.
9. Credit granted for passing the examination will be entered on the student's permanent record as hours earned. A grade will not be assigned.
10. If the student fails the examination, no entry will be made on the student's permanent record.
