ARTS MANAGEMENT AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS *(beginning Fall 2018)*

This certificate program is intended to develop the skills that students need to build successful careers as professional artists or to pursue careers in a variety of arts and community organizations. Students combine courses in an arts area (Art, Music, or Theater and Dance) with courses in Business, Communication, and Urban Studies. The certificate has two options; Arts Management, which emphasizes coursework in Business and Communication, and Community Development, which focuses on courses in Communication and Urban Studies.

The certificate requires 15 credit hours in addition to 9 credit hours of prerequisite courses, for a total of 24
