PRE-ART THERAPY CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS *(beginning Fall 2018)*

This certificate program is intended for students planning to pursue Art Therapy as a career path. Practicing as an Art Therapist in Ohio requires a Masters degree in the field and so the goal of the certificate is to prepare students for admission into an MA program. Students typically will be majors in Studio Art or Psychology or will have completed an undergraduate major in one of these areas. Students pursuing the certificate are encouraged to consider either double-majoring in the two areas, or adding a minor in either Psychology (for Studio Art majors) or Studio Art and Design (for Psychology majors), or taking additional coursework in both areas.

The certificate requires 21 credit hours in addition to 12 credit hours of prerequisite courses, for a total of 33 credit hours.
